Students who wish to earn medals can choose from the options below. All requirements must be completed by <u>May 1</u> in order to be considered for a Band Medal.

Perform an approved solo with live or recorded accompaniment. Music selections provided. Other selections must be approved. If performed on or before Feb 14, this will serve as an audition for the SUSD Honors Recital on March 1, 2018. This must be performed on your band instrument.
